

BYLAW #558

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH MUNICIPAL OFFICER POSITIONS.

WHEREAS section 196 of the *Municipal Act* RS Chap. 323 directs the Council of the Village of Montrose to establish certain officer positions, NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Montrose, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

SHORT TITLE

- 1. (1) This Bylaw may be cited as the **"MUNICIPAL OFFICER POSITIONS BYLAW"**.

OFFICER POSITIONS

- 2. (1) The position of "Village Administrator" is hereby established, to hold the responsibilities, powers, duties, and functions of the Chief Administrative Officer pursuant to section 197 of the *Municipal Act*.
(2) Council may, by resolution, appoint a Village Administrator.
- 3. (1) The position of "Village Clerk" is hereby established, to hold the corporate administration responsibilities, powers, duties, and functions pursuant to section 198 of the *Municipal Act*.
(2) Council may, by resolution, appoint a Village Clerk.
- 4. (1) The position of "Village Treasurer" is hereby established, to hold the financial administration responsibilities, powers, duties, and functions pursuant to section 199 of the *Municipal Act*.
(2) Council may, by resolution, appoint a Village Treasurer.
- 5. (1) Council may, by resolution, appoint deputy positions to any of the positions established under this bylaw.

ENACTMENT

- 6. (1) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the part that is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder.
(2) This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the final adoption thereof.
