- 1. BV Recreation had planned a graduation celebration for the high school graduates at Marsh Creek. The event has been cancelled due to lack of participation.
- 2. Montrose Recreation has planned Family Fun Day for June 4. Music will be provided by the group that hosts the Coffee House music at the Community Hall.

- 3. Reported to Council that the Village re-posted the Summer Student position. The Village did not receive applications for the position.
- 4. The outdoor exercise equipment has been installed at Frontier Park. Two children ignored the barricade placed to prevent entry and walked on the uncured surface. The surface now has divots.
- 5. A survey has been completed for the east end of 9th Avenue. The survey shows three issues with adjacent properties:
 - a. $925\ 10^{\text{th}}$ Avenue has deposited fill on the Village lot.
 - b. 940 9th Avenue has a shed located on the Village lot.
 - c. The Village has partially located a swale on 935 9^{th} Avenue.
