> Mayor Danchuk provided Council with a report released from the Mayors Caucus meetings. Reported that 86 Mayors attended the conference and that there will be a mayors session held before the UBCM conference in September.

Member Inquiry

CAO reported the following items: CAO

- 1. Informed Council about award of Montrose-Beaver Falls interconnect project to Marwest Industries for \$18, 380.
- 2. Updated Council on the status of the supply main failure project.
 - 140 loads of fill delivered on Saturday, estimated that another 75 will be required to finish pipe cover. Final haul days tentatively scheduled for Thursday.
 - Existing Supply main was flushed on Saturday, very dirty water encountered. Pumps ran until water cleared up.
 - Pipe installation commenced on Sunday, May 19 with completion of main run on May 22.
 - Most pipe and bypass valves are now installed. Testing to commence Thursday May 24.

- Opportunity to connect to Montrose system through bypass on May 25, 26 to remove stress from Beaver Falls and reduce water costs. This connection will still require careful management. Operational questions remain.
- Chamber retro-fit and base preparation to commence over the next few days.
- Valve delivery expected next week.
- Precision Pumps official does not see any issues with pumps not running on curve during failure event.
- Remediation works included final geotechnical inspection today on compaction for bank stability around structures and slope treatment. Materials testing to be completed May 23.
- Maglio's cost to date is \$98,000, Marwest costs \$13,500.
