SPRING YARD & GARDEN PICKUP

McKelvey Creek Landfill no longer accepts plastic bags or nylon tie ropes for yard and garden waste. These cannot be used for drop-off or pick-up.

Spring collection for leaves and branches will take place on **April 24th.** Please have your items at your regular garbage pickup location by 7:00am.

- Branches must be bundled (max. 4 feet long, 6-inch diameter) and securely tied.
- Leaves should be in compostable kraft bags or open plastic totes (max. 40lbs).

The Village is bringing back the yard & garden waste dumpster, it will be located beside the Fire Hall from April 16 to May 1 for garden waste, leaves, and branches ONLY. The site will be under video surveillance.

Please note: Plastic bags, loose leaves, clippings, or unbundled branches will NOT be picked up.

RDKB BEAR BIN TRADE-IN PROGRAM - *ORGANICS ONLY

The bears seem to be waking up earlier and earlier in our area, and the RDKB figured we'd get a head start letting our residents know that we have availability of these bear bins through our green bin trade-in program. These bins cost \$200, which includes GST, and they are a very robust animal resistant bin with a unique locking system. The bear resistant green bins are for organic waste collection only – not for garbage collection. Please call RDKB or visit their website for more information.
